What Does OXPOCUS Course Cover?

- FAMUS (Focussed Acute Medicine Ultrasound) syllabus and accreditation process.
- Basic ultrasound physics, knobology, examination technique
- Thoracic scanning
- Abdominal & renal scanning
- DVT, peripheral vascular scanning & vascular access
- Introduction to US guided LP

How Is the Course Structured?

Full day course is led by Acute Physicians/Intensive Care Physicians/Radiologists/Sonographers with extensive experience in Point-of-Care Ultrasound (POCUS).

Consists of alternating presentations, live demonstrations, and practical sessions with about four hours of hands-on scanning.

The group sessions use a range of different high quality POCUS ultrasound machines including handheld devices.

Scanning on healthy individuals & individuals with pathology in groups with a faculty supervisor.
