

Are you interested in POCUS? Do you have a game-changing case? Do you want the opportunity to present it in Cardiff?!

SAMCardiff includes our annual POCUS cases lightning session, where we are aiming to showcase the utility of point of care ultrasound within Acute Medicine. If you have an **anonymised** case (with good quality images) that you'd like to present, please consider applying now!

Applications require a brief (**<300 words**) abstract that can be submitted [here](#) outlining the case, the POCUS intervention and why it was memorable. These will be adjudicated, and successful authors invited to come and present the case in Cardiff within the main conference programme.

As previously, the best case presentation on the day voted by the audience will receive a £100 cash prize!

To apply you must:

- Submit a (maximum) 300-word abstract [here](#) by **2359hrs on Sunday 1 March 2026**
- Select the **POCUS Session Submission Category** when prompted
- Have good quality **anonymised** images of the case available

All clinicians involved in Acute Medicine are eligible to apply (non-Consultant grades encouraged).

For the purposes of anonymisation, we ask that you follow this guidance:

- Location of case (hospital / town / city) never required
- Specific age of case never required, avoid decade of age unless relevant
- Co-morbidities mentioned only if directly relevant to case
- Occupation, social history mentioned only if directly relevant to case (but keep as general as possible)

Those selected will be offered:

- A 10-minute presentation (can include brief evidence outline / teaching points if appropriate)
- 2-day conference attendance at no charge. **Please note travel and accommodation will not routinely be provided for speakers in this session - however, for any clinician who does not have access to a study budget which covers their travel, FAMUS will pay for your reasonable travel expenses in order to facilitate you to present (if selected, non-Consultants only).**
